

UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE CLAIMS

INITIAL CLAIMS:

15,607 REGULAR + 37,567 PUA

Regular initial claims down 2,230 claims, or 12.5%, compared to the previous week.

495,840 initial claims have been filed in 2020, 95.6% within the last 10 weeks.

Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) claims rose by 10,168, or 37.1%, compared to the previous week.

A claimant may have filed BOTH a regular initial claim and a PUA initial claim.

CONTINUED CLAIMS:

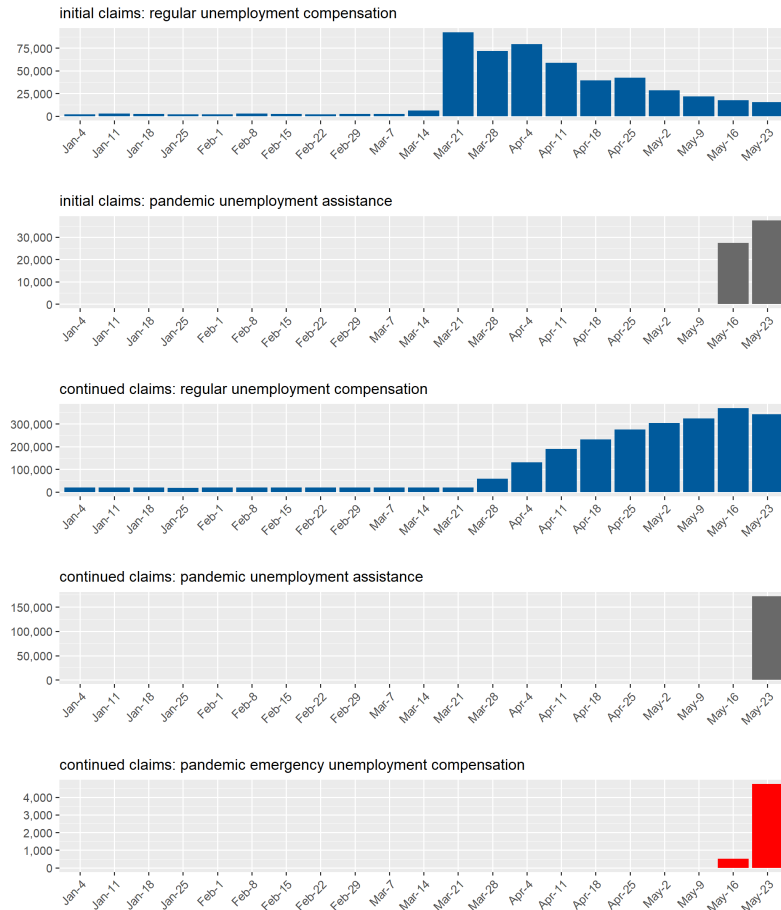
343,030 REGULAR + 172,346 PUA + 4,745 PEUC

Continued claims down 26,011 claims, or 7.0%, compared to the previous week.

Nevada's insured unemployment rate stands at 24.9%.

This is the 1st week where Nevada reported PUA continued claims. This total includes multiple benefit weeks.
