

UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE CLAIMS

INITIAL CLAIMS:

10,748 REGULAR + 16,201 PUA

Regular initial claims down 589 claims, or 5.2%, compared to the previous week.

517,925 initial claims have been filed in 2020, 95.8% within the last 13 weeks.

Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) claims fell by 2,499, or 13.4%, compared to the previous week.

A claimant may have filed BOTH a regular initial claim and a PUA initial claim.

CONTINUED CLAIMS:

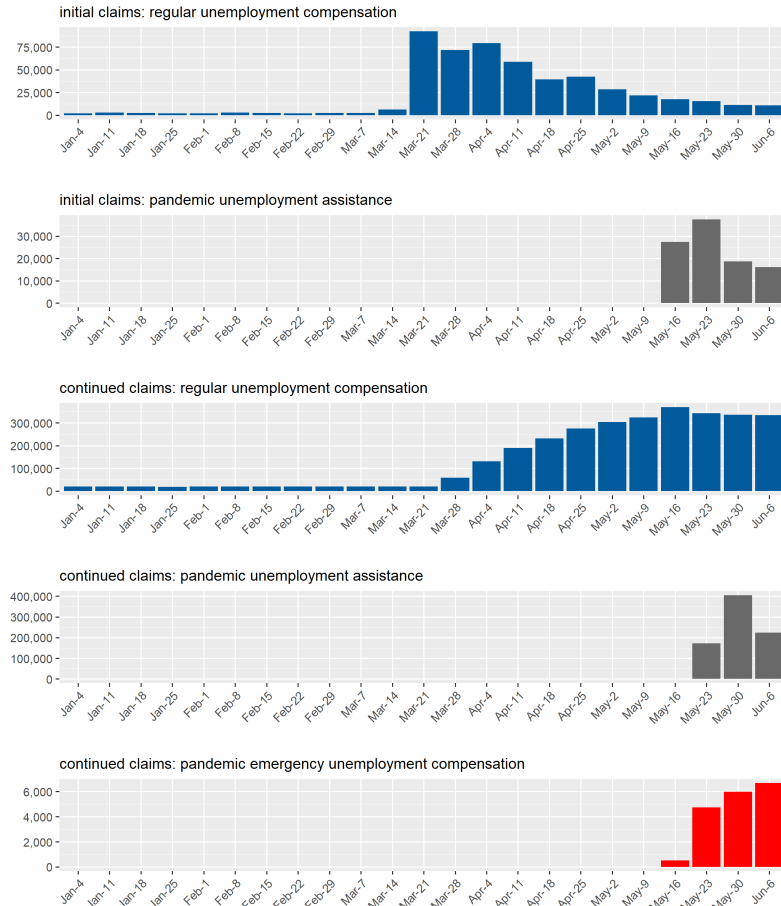
334,182 REGULAR + 224,574 PUA + 6,681 PEUC

Continued claims down 861 claims, or 0.3%, compared to the previous week.

Nevada's insured unemployment rate stands at 24.2%.

This is the 3rd week where Nevada reported PUA continued claims. This total includes multiple benefit weeks.
