**Nevada Health Response Guidance: Directive 035**  
**Vaccination Events**  
**January 30, 2021**

**Vaccination events are not subject to the capacity limitations in Directive 035.**

Directive 035 generally imposes capacity limitations on indoor and outdoor venues and limits the size of gatherings in order to curb the spread of COVID-19. However, vaccination events and similar gatherings for the purpose of providing emergency or medical services to the public are exempted from these limitations pursuant to Section 8 of Directive 035.

Accordingly, vaccination events do not need to comply with the 25% of fire code capacity or 50 person limitations.

**Vaccination events must still follow safety protocols.**

Although vaccination events are exempt from the capacity limitations, all persons are still required to follow safety protocols including wearing a face covering and social distancing. The number of persons allowed in the area must not exceed the number that can be accommodated with proper social distancing between households.

**Exception applies only to spaces actually hosting vaccination events.**

The exception to the capacity limitations applies only to spaces where and when a vaccination event or similar event is actually occurring. For example, if a gaming property hosts a vaccination event in a ballroom, the exception applies only to the ballroom while the event is occurring; the casino floor is not exempt.
