Esmeralda County Sheriff's Office will continue to monitor the COVID-19 measures and indicators to determine the nature of the virus within our communities.

We are working with the senior transportation to make sure our vulnerable populations and seniors are getting the right PPE and making sure they are safe when they are in transit in County vehicles.

All testing is being done outside Esmeralda County due to the fact of no hospitals/medical care establishments are located within the County.

Esmeralda County Sheriff's office is working with Nevada Department of Health and Human Services to provide the residence of Esmeralda County with the most up-to-date information that we can provide.

Esmeralda County Sheriff's office has been putting up flyers and talking with the residence about the COVID-19 vaccinations and how to receive them.

Listed below is the mitigation measures for Esmeralda County;

Public Gatherings & Events

Capacity:

Limited to no more than 250 individuals or 50 percent of fire code

Large Gatherings plans:

Limited to no more than 250 individuals or 50 percent of fire code

Private Gatherings & Events

Capacity:

Restricted to 10 people indoors and 25 people outdoors

Food and Beverage Establishments

Capacity:

Indoor dining is allowed and no more than 50 percent occupancy of fire code

Reservations:

Not required

Bar Seating:

Patrons sitting at a table or booth must only be served via table service, bar tops if spaced 6ft apart

Additional Measures:

Restaurants and bars should continue to have hand sanitizer available

Places of Worship

Capacity:

No more than 50 percent occupancy of fire code

Gyms, Fitness, Dance, Yoga, Martial Arts Studios

No more than 50 percent occupancy of fire code

Should continue to have hand sanitizer available
